Owen had spotted Steve and immediately rushed to him, focusing only on one face which stood out above the crowd. # (In other words!)

**1.** Who asked that his killers not be charged with what they were doing wrong?

2. What king offered clothing, gold and political power to the one who could read and explain a "writing"?

**3.** Who asked God if he was responsible for his brother's welfare?

**4.** Who indicated that his teacher had not fully convinced him to follow Christ?

**5.** Who talked to Jesus about the eating habits of canines?

**6.** What was done to help an elderly king stay warm?

7. Who recognized characteristics of both his sons that were evident in the younger of the two?

### Answers for week of February 12

1. In a picturesque passage, idolaters are compared to that which will vanish quickly, including morning vapor (*cloud*) and condensation (*dew*), chimney smoke, and waste materials from threshing (*chaff*) blown away. Find it.

Answer: All four are found in Hosea 13 Hosea 13: 1 When Ephraim spake trembling, he exalted himself in Israel; but when he offended in Baal, he died. 2 And now they sin more and more, and have made them molten images of their silver, and idols according to their own understanding, all of it the work of the craftsmen: they say of them, Let the men that sacrifice kiss the calves. 3 Therefore they shall be as the morning cloud and as the early dew that passeth away, as the chaff that is driven with the whirlwind out of the floor, and as the smoke out of the chimney.

Comment: The rise and fall of the tribe of Ephraim is said to have been related to their attitude toward God and Baal. In Hosea's day idolatry was rampant, and <u>the idolaters' destruction was eminent.</u> 2. What were the meek to seek in order to escape God's wrath?

Answer: They were to seek the LORD, righteousness and meekness (Zeph 2:3) Zephaniah 2:1 Gather yourselves together, yea, gather together, O nation not desired; 2 Before the decree bring forth, before the day pass as the chaff, before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD's anger come upon you. 3 Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD's anger. 3. What source of light is compared to a life that "goes out"?

**Answer: lamp, candle, spark.** The demise of the wicked is described as a flame on a candle or in a lamp being put out.

Prov 13:9 The light of the righteous rejoiceth: but the **lamp of the wicked shall be put out**.

Prov 20:20 Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness.

Prov 24:19-20 Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the

wicked; {20} For there shall be no reward to the evil man; the **candle of the wicked shall be put out.** 

Job 18:1 Then answered Bildad the Shuhite, and said, 2 How long will it be ere ye make an end of words? mark, and afterwards we will speak. 3 Wherefore are we counted as beasts, and reputed vile in your sight? 4 He teareth himself in his anger: shall the earth be forsaken for thee? and shall the rock be removed out of his place? 5 Yea, the **light** of the wicked shall be put out, and the **spark** of his fire shall not shine. 6 The light shall be dark in his tabernacle, and **his candle shall be put out** with him.

Job 21:1 But Job answered and said, ... 7 Wherefore do the wicked live, become old, yea, are mighty in power?... 16 Lo, their good is not in their hand: the counsel of the wicked is far from me. 17 How oft is **the candle of the wicked put out**! and how oft cometh their destruction upon them! God distributeth sorrows in his anger.

4. Who compared his past life to a time when God lighted his path with a candle? Answer: Job. Verse 2 speaks of the past, verse 3 speaks of the candle (lamp), and the rest of the chapter has Job recounting situations from the past when life was better. Job 29:1 Moreover Job continued his parable, and said, 2 Oh that I were as in months past, as in the days when God preserved me: 3 When his candle shined upon my head, and when by his light I walked through darkness; 4 As I was in the days of my youth, when the secret of God was upon my tabernacle; 5 When the Almighty was yet with me, when my children were about me:

**5.** The secrets of men always seem to come to light. What teacher illustrated that idea using the common practice of placing a light in an elevated place rather than down low? **Answer: Jesus** 

(Mark 4:21-23) And he said unto them, Is a candle brought to be put under a bushel, or under a bed? and not to be set on a candlestick? {22} For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad. {23} If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.

(Luke 8:16-17) No man, when he hath lighted a **candle**, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth it under a bed; but **setteth it on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light.** {17} For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.

**6.** With what shall those who practice hypocrisy be surprised?

# Answer: Fearfulness

(Isa 33:14) The sinners in Zion are afraid; **fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites**. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?

7. What six characteristics describe the spirit of the Lord as it stayed upon a descendant of Jesse?

# Answer: Wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge, and fear of the Lord.

(Isa 11:1-2) And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: {2} And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
