Religion? Or Way of Life?

Much controversy erupted in Rutherford County when it was announced that area Muslims had plans to build a huge complex including a mosque on Bradyville Pike. The opposition that erupted made the Muslims look like martyrs, and publicized their cause even to the extent of national publicity. Demonstrations and counter-demonstrations have been highly emotional and fervent.

It was said by opponents that their opposition was not an attack on freedom of religion as guaranteed in the constitution, but a protest of procedure and proper notification about zoning hearings. Yet it is clear that many opponents were also concerned that the Muslims would put into practice what many have already done, and attack those who are non-Muslims. There is no doubt that a serious percentage of Muslims have that as their goal. But articles in the DNJ have portrayed the local Muslims as peaceful people who merely want to enjoy constitutional religious freedom of religion.

Be that as it may, it is even more disturbing to see Islam portrayed as a "way of life", not just a way of religion. But Christianity is supposedly not so serious a threat because religion is just a part of a much bigger LIFE. WHAT???

The popular view is that Christianity is not a shaping and controlling force in the lives of its practitioners. But it is supposed to be!

(Mat 10:34-39) Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. 35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. 36 And a man's foes shall be they of his own household. 37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. 38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. 39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

(Gal 2:20) I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
