6. What passage contains a request for a blessing (from each member of the Godhead) upon the readers?

7. What tribe of Israel seemed to be the leader in idolatry and Baal worship? Give the reference from a book of prophecy.

Sexual intentions:

Habakkuk 2:15 Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that puttest thy bottle to him, and makest him drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

Lot's daughters offered strong drink to their father, to make him drunk. Their motive -- that they each might go in to him to lie with him. "Come, let us make our father drink wine, and we will lie with him, that we may preserve seed of our father. And they made their father drink wine that night: and the firstborn went in, and lay with her father; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose. And it came to pass on the morrow, that the firstborn said unto the younger, Behold, I lay yesternight with my father: let us make him drink wine this night also; and go thou in, and lie with him, that we may preserve seed of our father. And they made their father drink wine that night also: and the younger arose, and lay with him; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose." - Genesis 19:32-35

Medical/psychological :

Pro 31:6 Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts. 7 Let him drink, and forget his poverty, and remember his misery no more.

For self-advantage: David compelled Uriah to take strong drink, in an effort to cause him to go to his house. "And when David had called him, he did eat and drink before him; and he made him drunk: and at even he went out to lie on his bed with the servants of his lord, but went not down to his house." - 2 Samuel 11:10-13

2. What group of people are compared to a body of water that has become very dirty due to its turbulence? Give the reference.

Answer: The wicked. "But the wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt." - Isaiah 57:20

3. What ancient city was condemned to be destroyed for its attitude that there was "no city besides me."?

Answer: Nineveh - Zeph 2:15, This is the exultant city Which dwells securely, Who says in her heart, "I am, and there is no one besides me." How she has become a desolation, A resting place for beasts! Everyone who passes by her will hiss And wave his hand in contempt. (Nineveh is named in verse 13)

4. Descendants of ______, a Levite, were assigned to make sacrifices after the children of Israel and other Levites had strayed away from God. (Other Levites could serve in other ways, but were forbidden to be priests.) Fill in the blank.

Answer: Zadok

Eze 44:15 But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, that kept the charge of my sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from me, they shall come near to me to minister unto me, and they shall stand before me to offer unto me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord GOD: ... - Ezekiel 48:11 - "It shall be for the priests that are sanctified of the sons of Zadok; which have kept my charge, which went not astray when the children of Israel went astray, as the Levites went astray."
